DPW Department Reports:

Hawes reported that on June 5th aerators were power washed. On June 9th John Grunderman replaced the Ferg Drive in well house #3. New planters were set on Main Street on June 12th. On June 13th repairs were made the the brush hog. The fill dirt located in the DPW is being removed in anticipation of the construction project to occur on M-99 in August. During removal of the fill, the backhoe broke down. Repair processes are being researched by Bailey Excavating. The possibility of purchasing a new backhoe was discussed by council. It was also mentioned that K2 was in need of repairs before it could be used again and that the BadBoy needed a new battery.

Love reported CCR report has been submitted and is complete. The report went out to the public in this months water billing. Quality Asphalt was in and overlaid bad spots in roads as discussed. Jac Court was inadvertently missed and discussions have been had about Quality coming back to complete the project or checking with another company to repair that spot. Summerfest went very well. Woodchucks at the lagoons are in the process of being dealt with. In response to the storm in the early morning hours of Friday June 7th the generator was ran at the Green St lift due to power outages and 13 loads of brush were removed from the village.
